Step 1: Joining Criteria

- Read the *Joining Criteria* (Form A1) to ascertain the skill requirements to become a Stunt Performer.
 - Complete the *New Applicant Form* (Form A2).

Step 2: Industry Relevant Experience

- If you have any previous experience working on set, complete the *Industry Relevant Experience Form* (Form A3).
 - Include details of productions you've worked on, who you worked for, your role, and a reference from your employer.

Step 3: Stunt Competency Skills

- Once you are confident with your skill set, it will be your responsibility to film and edit your skills in the same layout as the *SASA Competency Skills Form (Form B1)* and submit this to the SASA Board.
 - At the start of your video, include a brief introduction about yourself and your interest in stunts.

Step 4: Submission and Review

- Upload your completed video to YouTube and email the link together with your completed forms.
 - After receiving your forms and video, the Competency Test Committee will review your application and provide feedback.
 - If you meet the Criteria and pass the Stunt Competency Test, you will be invited to join SASA, and further information will be sent.
